

File note to telephone call with Kathy Jackson

Present: Fiona Roughley, Matthew Ashworth and Kathy Jackson [telephone]

Date: 25 July 2014

Time: Approx 7pm

1. Fiona greeted Kathy and asked her if it was an appropriate time to speak.
2. Kathy said that it was an appropriate time.
3. Fiona said that she was sorry to hear about Michael and his admission to hospital and that she hoped he would be ok.
4. Kathy said that she had just arrived at the hospital to see Michael.
5. Fiona informed Kathy that the Commission was planning to hold a hearing on Wednesday 30 July 2014.
6. Fiona asked Kathy if she was available that day to appear to give evidence as a continuation of the previous block of hearings.
7. Fiona then explained to Kathy that the Commission intended to hold the hearing and the focus was to be the NHDA. Fiona also said that Jeremy expected the hearing would take about half the day.
8. Kathy said that she would be available to attend on Wednesday.
9. Fiona said that this was being done for a number of reasons:
 - a. The Commission has since the last hearing obtained additional material relating to the NHDA;
 - b. The Commission intends to hold the hearing as there is a good chance the material will come out in the media shortly;
 - c. To give Kathy the chance to respond to the evidence and to some of the claims being made in the media regarding the NHDA.
10. Kathy indicated that she understood and agreed that this was probably a good idea.
11. Kathy raised a number of the media articles that had been published about her. In particular she raised an article written by Ben Schneiders and published on 25 July about the Peter Mac issue.
12. Kathy then said that she had sent information to Michael Smith and wrote a reply to Ben Schneiders and his article, but that The Age disregarded her reply.
13. Fiona then asked Kathy if she recalled being asked after the last hearing to think about some of the payments made from the NHDA and then told Kathy that she should think about those transactions before the hearing on Wednesday.
14. In particular, Fiona told Kathy that she should try and remember some examples of who the cash withdrawals from the NHDA were given to.
15. Fiona then told Kathy that the Commission would email through a new summons to her. Fiona asked if the summons could be served on Kathy at her address.
16. Kathy told Fiona that she would attend the Commission's office on Monday to collect the summons in person and that she would be in contact with myself about the time she would be arriving. She indicated it would probably be Monday morning.

17. Kathy said that the media keeps calling her at the moment and so she does not answer her phone unless she knows who the caller is.
18. Kathy also indicated that Andrew Landeryou is consistently posting material about her that she is concerned about.
19. Kathy said that she send through a document to the Commission to spell things out by the end of the next week.
