

## Changes to Planning Controls that may affect you

Council has recently completed a review of planning controls for the City of Blacktown. As a result of this review, a new set of planning controls have been developed and included in a document called the Draft Blacktown Local Environmental Plan 2013 (BLEP 2013). The Draft BLEP 2013 commences exhibition this week, for review and comment by the public from 23 January to 19 April 2013.

We understand that many people may not know what a LEP is or what it does. To assist you I have enclosed the following items:

- A brochure that explains what a LEP is, why a new LEP has been prepared, where the draft LEP
  can be viewed and how you can provide comments on the draft LEP.
- Selected Fact Sheets that explain aspects of Draft BLEP 2013 that relate specifically to your property.

Find out how BLEP 2013 will affect your property and your City.

Draft BLEP 2013 proposes some significant changes to zonings and development controls that will affect how land in Blacktown can be developed in the future. The following table identifies the key aspects of Draft BLEP 2013 that will affect your property.


