PRACTICE DIRECTION PD1/A

A DIRECTION FOR THE FILING OF DOCUMENTS

IN RESPONSE TO THE EVIDENCE RECEIVED 16 – 20 JUNE 2014

DURING THE COMMISSION'S HEARINGS INTO THE HEALTH SERVICES UNION

Pursuant to paragraph 46 of Practice Direction 1, the Commissioner makes the following Direction (**PD1/A**).

1. All persons wishing to file with the Office of the Commission documents responsive to the evidence received between 16 and 20 June 2014 during the Commission's hearings into the Health Services Union, must file with the Office of the Commission, on or before **Friday, 11 July 2014**, a document (a **Notice of Intention**) stating:
 - a. the names of all persons who will sign a statement of the kind mentioned in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 46 of Practice Direction 1 to be filed by the Applicant; and
 - b. the names of any witnesses (if any) whom the Applicant will be requesting leave to cross-examine.
2. **Friday, 18 July 2014** is designated as the date by which an Applicant (as that term is defined in paragraph 46 of Practice Direction 1) must file documents of the kind set out in that paragraph.
